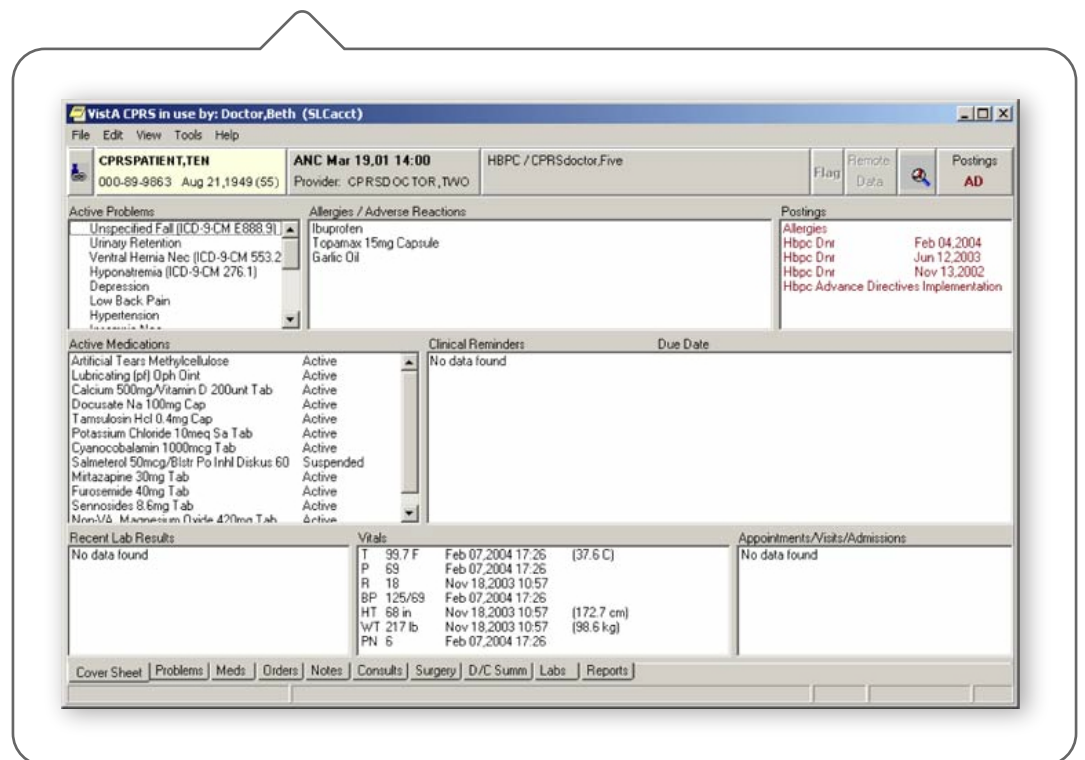
I. What's an EHR, and why is it important?
